*THE TEN COMMANDMENTS: THE LAW OF LOVE*

Then God spoke all these words, saying:

**I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery.**

You shall have no other gods before Me.

**You shall not make for yourself an idol, or any likeness of what is in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the water under the earth.**

You shall not worship them or serve them; for I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children, on the third and the fourth generations of those who hate Me.

**But showing loving kindness to thousands, to those who love Me and keep My commandments.**

You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain, for the Lord will not leave him unpunished who takes His name in vain.

**Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.**

Six days you shall labor and do all your work,

**But the seventh day is a Sabbath of the Lord your God; in it you shall not do any work, you or your son or your daughter, your mate or your female servant or your cattle or your sojourner who stays with you.**

For in six days the Lord made the heavens and the earth, the sea and all that is in them, and rested on the seventh day; therefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.

**Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be prolonged in the land which the Lord your God gives you.**

You shall not murder.

**You shall not commit adultery.**

You shall not steal.

**You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.**

You shall not covet your neighbor's house; you shall not covet your neighbor's wife or his male servant or his female

servant or his ox or his donkey or anything that belongs to your neighbor. ~ (Exodus 20:1-17)

**Jesus said...You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the great and foremost commandment.**

And a second is like it. You shall love your neighbor as yourself.

**On these two commandments depend the whole Law and the Prophets.** ~ (Matthew 22:37-40)
