

## Calvary Youth Driving Policy July 2007

Parents:

The following is the Youth Driving Policy. Please read the guidelines below and sign, indicating your agreement with the policy. Any questions or comments can be directed to an adult member of the youth leadership team.

When youth are involved with an approved Calvary Presbyterian Church YAC event, the following guidelines will be enforced concerning transportation.

- All drivers for youth events will be 22 years old or older.
- Youth trips will start from, and return to, designated locations (which usually will be, but are not limited to, the church)
- During the trip only Calvary-approved adults will drive (approved adults based on both items #1 and the youth protection policy). Exceptions to this rule (for example if a youth is coming directly to an activity from work) would need to be arranged with a youth leader in advance.
- There will always be a seat belt for each occupant of the vehicle. Drivers will require all passengers to wear seat belts
- Transportation before and after an event (i.e. bringing youth to the designated departure site and back home) is the responsibility of the parents, not Calvary. Youth will only be released from the event to depart with their parents or siblings unless specific permission to be released to someone else has been supplied by the parent to a youth leader.
